PSRM CONTINUES TO OFFER CONTINUING MEDICAL EDUCATION in the NEW NORMAL



Despite the many setbacks brought about by the COVID-19 pandemic for the most part of 2020, the PSRM marched on and continued its quest for continuing quality medical education not only for its members, but also to non-RM practitioners.

The PSRM partnered with UAP and have staged 3 online webinars thus far, as part of the CME outreach caravan. More outreach webinars are still to come, and will all be completed before the end of the year.

The first online CME outreach lectures were held on May 12, 2020. Dr Angela S. Aguilar lectured on "Endometriosis: New Paradigm in the New Normal Era" and Dr Melissa F. Diawatan gave a lecture on "AUB in the time of pandemic"





The second online PSRM CME webinar was held on July 11, 2020, where Dr Cynthia Salazar-Balila lectured on PCOS, and Dr Thea Ancheta gave some very useful and practical tips on "Nutrition and Infertility".



The third PSRM CME webinar was held last August 22, 2020. Dr Rey Castillo lectured on "Endometriosis" and Dr Thea Ancheta gave a repeat lecture on "Nutrition and Infertility".

CPG on POLYCYSTIC OVARY SYNDROME (2020)

The PSRM, under the able leadership of our current president Dr Marinella Agnes G. Abat, is set to release an update on the clinical practice guidelines on PCOS this year. The editors-in-chief are Dr Delfin A. Tan and Dr Maria Antonia E. Habana. The first edition of the PCOS CPG was published in 2009, under the leadership of Dr Eileen M. Manalo.

For this year's 2nd edition of the PCOS CPG, the editorial board assembled an impressive group of Reproductive medicine specialists who are tasked to meticulously scan and critique the most current scientific evidence on PCOS, and synthesize the myriad information in one comprehensive book of guidelines, that will be specifically adapted to the needs of the Filipino woman. The publication will include the following topics:

- 1. Diagnostic criteria
- 2. Pathophysiology
- 3.L.ong term health consequences
- 4. Guidelines in the management of PCOS (includes AUB, hyperandrogenism, infertility, asdolescents, pregnancy, long term consequences)
- 5. role of prevention

Target date for the plenary (online) critiquing will be on the last week of September 2020, with target release of the published manuscript on December 2020.

We have planned to have a bigger second IVF series, after its first successful run last year at the Edsa Shangrila. While last year's 3 part series talked about the basics of IVF and case discussions, for this year we have designed a more advanced curriculum tackling PCOS and Endometriosis. It was envisioned to be a 3 part 5 segment series, culminating in a hands on with actual cases for stimulation, OPU and possible embryo transfer 1 week prior to the PSRM Midyear in Cebu. We have enlisted the support of our industry partners Merck, Ferring and BSV for this activity with Repro Optima as the host IVF lab. Then the COVID 19 pandemic happened...

Not to be dampened by the ongoing turmoil, the board has decided to convert the program into the PSRM IVF Series Webinar. On the bright side, the webinar series was made available to all members, all over the country within the safety and confines of their own homes. With this it was able to address knowledge gaps in the practice of ART whilst keeping with the quarantine directives. The first of the 2 part of the series was on PCOS and IVF held on July 10 and 17, 2020. Topics such as pathophysiology of PCOS related infertility, adjuvants for IVF in the PCOS patient, choosing the right stimulation protocol and IVF cases were delivered by the following speakers, Drs Gia Pastorfide, Eileen Manalo, Jing Fernandez and Anthony Ancheta. The 2 segments of the first part garnered the following attendees, 90 and 98 respectively.

The second part was on Endometriosis and IVF and likewise had 2 segments held on August 7 and 14, 2020. Topics such as pathophysiology of Endometriosis related infertility, adjuvants for IVF in the Endometriosis patient, choosing the right stimulation protocol and IVF cases were delivered by the following speakers, Drs Angela Aguilar, Dan Milla, Debbie Meguizo and Marivic Tan. The 2 segments of this second part garnered identical number of attendees, 90 and 98 aswell. Each part had a post-test administered in compliance with the requirement to be able to issue CPD units for the activities. These post tests were given via an "online game" platform which has made the members' participation more enjoyable.

Needless to say with the cancellation of the Midyear, the part 3 was cancelled as well, but should be highly anticipated once we can all resume face to face gatherings, prayerfully in the very near future. Till then let's all keep safe and may we all continue to be blessed and be blessings to others!

The roster of speakers include no less than renowned local speakers, Dr. Delfin Tan, Dr. Lilia Luna, Dr. Virgilio Novero, Jr., and Dr. Rudie Frederick Mendiola and international RM experts Prof. Sony Sukhbir Singh of Canada and Prof. Georg Griesinger from Germany.
