
On October 7, a one day Workshop on Assisted Re-

PSREI ETHICS AND PRACTICE GUIDELINES

WORKSHOP HELD

A workshop was held July 25, 2011 at the Diamond Hotel conducted by the PSREI Committee on Ethics chair Dr. Santiago del Rosario to review and update the 2006 Guidelines on the Ethics and Practice of Assisted Reproductive Technology & Intrauterine Insemination. In attendance were the present members of the Board of Directors and the past PSREI presidents. The discussions were highlighted by with the participation of guests Dr. Marita V. T. Reyes, Atty. Albert D. Rebosa and Dr. Ma. Corazon Zaida N. Gamilla as they shared their thoughts on the subject matter as a bioethicist, a lawyer and a stakeholder respectively to give added perspective.

The output of the said workshop resulted in the addition of four new ethical guidelines and the changing in the position of two. The rest were deemed still applicable and were either retained as is or modified slightly. Later, in the same week that PSREI had our ethics workshop, the Philippine Obstetrical and Gynecological Society (POGS) presented their own revisions to the mother society's Ethical Guidelines in Obstetrical and Gynecological Practice, Medical Education, and Research to its general membership. PSREI was very well represented during that occasion. All of POGS guidelines pertinent to the practice of ART and IUI were found to be in concurrence with that of ours.

The *ad hoc* Regulatory Board for the Practice of ART and IUI headed by Dr. Leonardo Almeda has also come out with Practice Guidelines that will be implemented soon. This aims not only to standardize the quality of ART practice in the country, but

also to monitor the standards of IVF Centers as well.

Outputs of both the Ethics
Committee and ART Regulatory Board will both come out in the Ethical Principles and Practice Guidelines on Assisted Reproductive Technology Handbook which will be made available to members. Production of handbooks is courtesy of Cordlife Philippines.

Proposals to amend the Society By-Laws to have the Committee on Ethics and the Regulatory Board on the Practice of Assisted Reproductive Technology as standing committees were prepared by the Committee on Amendments chaired by Dr. Delfin A. Tan for presentation in this year's business meeting.

PSGE GRANTS PSREI REQUEST

In 2010, Dr. Virgilio M. Novero Jr. as president of PSREI requested the Philippine Society for Gynecologic Endoscopy (PSGE) to waive the requirements needed for the application of PSREI fellow members seeking Fellow Status in the PSGE.

In March 2011, PSGE president, Dr. Ma. Corazon Zaida N. Gamilla, wrote to inform the present PSREI board that they are allowing a waiver of the practical examination requirement. However the rest of the requirements remain the same.

The PSREI membership was informed through e-mail by the secretariat of the following requirements to avail of this waiver:

- 1. the applicant is a duly certified fellow of the PSREI
- 2. the applicant must submit in writing his or her petition to waive the practical examination as part of the requirements to attain fellow status in PSGE
- the petition will be subject to the review and recommendation of the credentialing committee and to the final approval of the PSGE board

The scientific program was con-

ceptualized by our past president, Dr. Delfin A. Tan. The morning session was focused on male infertility, its factors, diagnosis, surgical and medical treatment which was ably given by Drs. Frances Monette Bragais, Dennis G. Lusaya, Paul Anthony Sunga, Virgilio M. Novero, Jr. and Joan Tan Garcia. The MSD sponsored lunch symposium was satisfactorily provided by Professor Suresh Nair, the immediate past president of the Singapore Society of Obstetrics & Gynecology. He tackled different aspects in controlled ovarian stimulation protocols, trouble shooting during IVF procedures and different strategies to improve success of ART he recommends. The

afternoon session on female infertility had Drs. Eileen Co-Sy, Sonia Castro-Rodriguez, Leonardo Almeda, Marlyn T. Dee, Delfin A. Tan, and Paul Plateau.

Professor Paul Plateau is from Brussels Free University gave a comprehensive talk on "Luteal Phase support and for first trimester threatened miscarriage" which is the launching of intravaginal progesterone product from Invida. All in all, every one who stayed up till the end of the program were satisfied. We shall aim to have similar midyear convention scientific program in the future to enhance our management of different problems of infertility.
