Keynote Speaker:



Ernesto Bosch, MD, PhD

For this year's annual convention, themed "Moving Forward: New Perspectives in Reproductive Medicine", we invited a global key opinion leader with wide international experience. Through the help of Merck Serono we were able to invite Dr. Ernest Bosch. He specialized in Obstetrics and Gynecology at the Hospital La Fe in Valencia, Spain and continued his training in Human Reproduction in the Hospital of the University of Pennsylvania.

Since January 2000 he has been working for the Human Reproduction Unit of the Instituto Valenciano de Infertilidad in Valencia, and has published 19 papers in this field. His areas of expertise are LH hCG differentiation, Utilization of r-LH and r-FSH, Agonist and Antagonist protocols, Recombinants vs Urinaries, and Biomarkers of ovarian response.

He was the recipient of the Scientific Program Prize Paper Award at the 2008 Annual Meeting of the American Society for Reproductive Medicine.
