

MESSAGE FROM THE PRESIDENT

2014 is a special year as we celebrate the 20th year of PSREI. In addition to the traditional midyear and annual conventions, we have packed the vear with a run, workshops on CPG updates, CME lecture series, research incentives, a constitutional convention, and a culminating event to celebrate our 20th year anniversary.

First off is "The Million Woman March for Endometriosis", spearheaded by the Dr. Camran Nezhat and his group of specialists in Washington DC, and cosponsored by the American College of Obstetricians and Gynecologists (ACOG), American Society of Reproductive Medicine (ASRM), American Association of Gynecologic Laparoscopists (AAGL) and the World Endometriosis Society (WES). Around 50 countries all over the world are participating in this event. PSREI joins this global campaign by sponsoring not just a march, but a RUN, that will coincide with the worldwide event on March 9. This is a momentous occasion, being our first collaboration with international medical societies for global awareness of a particular disease. So on March 9, I challenge you to wake up early, put on your trainers and march, walk, or run with us in Camp Aguinaldo and be part of endometriosis awareness and PSREI history!

In line with the theme of our run, we will also work on the Clinical Practice Guidelines in Endometriosis. This was first published by our Society in 2008. The taskforce on this CPG will be asking again for our fellows' help to research and deliberate on the different topics and have the 2014 Updates on the CPG out in time for our annual convention.

Last year's midyear convention was innovative, since the entire day's lectures focused only on PCOS. Itwas a success. attended by nearly 300 general obstetrician-gynecologists and REI specialists. So for this year's midyear convention, we will again discuss in detail one specific disease entity, that of endometriosis. This will be on May 19 at the Crowne Plaza.

The Society's CME lectures were reviewed and updated last year. This year we will continue to have our lecture series in the different areas outside the National Capitol Region on the following topics: AUB, infertility, PCOS and fertility control.

Another important event for this year is the plan to have a constitutional convention to review some issues relevant to the needs of our Society. Headed by Dr. Florante Gonzaga and Dr. Delfin Tan, the Chair and members of the Committee on Amendments and all past presidents of the Society will convene,

the outcome of the ConCon.

This year, the Society will award a research grant to any fellow who has a research paper for presentation in a foreign congress. This is to encourage top quality local researches to be conducted by our fellows.

Lastly, our three-day annual convention will feature an excellent list of topics, with prime local and foreign speakers. This will be at the EDSA Shangri-la Hotel on October 8-10. Our fellowship night will highlight the history of PSREI, and will gather all past presidents, fellows per batch, and affiliate members. It will be an evening full of nostalgia, joy and thanksgiving. Fellows will be given PSREI memorabilia and gift tokens to commemorate our 20th anniversary.

I invite you to attend all our activities and feel the spirit of "PSREI-hood"; to be among colleagues, mentors, batchmates, and friends. celebrate with our PSREI family!



PSREI Outreach Program for 2014

Since 2006 when the PSREI Outreach Program was established, 17 provinces have already been visited. Our lecturers have been to Cebu, Baguio, Davao, Laoag, Angeles, Bacolod, Tacloban, Surigao, Lucena, Ilocos Sur, Cabanatuan, Naga, Dagupan City, Iloilo, CDO, Pampanga and Bohol. All of these were very well attended by the local practitioners.

This year we again aim to visit the different regions to give updates to fellow obstetricians. The first of a series of PSREI Outreach was held last February 22, 2014 in Region 10. 70 participants attended at the SEDA Hotel, Cagayan de Oro City. The course overview was given by Dr. Gladys G. Tanangonan, chair of the outreach program. Dr. Rosiebel Esguerra gave a lecture on "Fertility Control: Medical"

Eligibility Criteria". Dr. Katherine Lipana talked on the topic "Work-up of the Infertile Couple". Dr. Madonna Victoria C. Domingo discussed "Abnormal Uterine Bleeding". Dr. Gladys Tanangonan lectured "Polycystic Ovary Syndrome". Dr. Regina Paz Tan-Espiritu delivered the Iuncheon symposium on "Recurrent Pregnancy Losses".

Last May 11, 2014 the second PSREI Outreach was held at the Baguio Country Club. This was attended by 85 participants from Regions 1, 2 and CAR. The PSREI caravan was joined by Dr. Ana Belen Alensuela, Dr. Jing Fernandez and Dr. Cynthia Balila.

Three other destinations, Regions 4, 6 and 11 are scheduled for the rest of the year.
